



Hong Kong Dance Yearbook 2013-2014

Info Solicitation

Supported by Hong Kong Arts Development Council, Hong Kong Dance Sector Joint Conference (HKDJC) will publish the *Hong Kong Dance Yearbook 2013-2014*, a biennial documentation of local dance activities, organizations, dancers and choreographers. Since its inception in 2000, the coming edition would be the fifth in the Yearbook series and has been evolving to become a comprehensive archive to review local dance scene.

Following the previous editions, the content of Yearbook is divided into organizations and event records, a list of reviews, publication and DVDs records, plus a number of features reflecting the recent growth of local dance scene. Instead of presenting a bundle of choreographers and dancers, the publication this year would present only a few outstanding artists whose contribution is publicly recognized through major local dance awards.

Solicited information will be uploaded to Yearbook website which database now accumulates dance information from 2006. However, the success of this valuable reference would greatly rely on your participation and support. Below please find the details:

**I. Organizations**

Any organization which fulfills one of the following criteria between 1 January, 2013 and 31 December, 2014 are welcome to submit their organization info.

- A. As a presenter or a production unit to produce a local or overseas **performance** of no shorter than one hour with dancing as the main component, which is solely planned, organized and performed by a local group, institute or organization and which has been promoted and its tickets sold to the public, with the supporting of relevant posters, programme booklets or promotional leaflets.
- B. As a presenter or a production unit to organize a local **programme\*** of no shorter than one hour with the main objective to promote, develop and/ or study dance, such as a forum and a workshop (excluding dance teaching programmes), which is solely planned, organized and implemented by a local group, institute or organization and which been promoted to the public and having been open for public enrollment, with the supporting of relevant posters, programme booklets or promotional leaflets.
- C. Any organization releases **a publication and/or DVD** distributed or sold locally with content related to the dance industry in Hong Kong.
- D. Any organization, supported by Hong Kong Arts Development Council, Home Affairs Bureau or other equivalent organizations, which entered into a dance competition and received recognized award in mainland China or overseas dance competition.

\*Programmes of cross-disciplinary arts such as musicals, concerts or acrobatics and free programmes hosted by commercial entities are excluded.

### **Info Submission**

Interested parties should fill in designated forms and return the completed forms with poster/flyers and programme booklet to Hong Kong Dance Sector Joint Conference Secretariat via email or postage no later than **27 February, 2015** (Friday).

1. The Yearbook Editorial Board reserves the final right to decide the publication of submitted info.
2. All submitted photos must have the consent from copyright owner.
3. All submitted info will be used for the Yearbook project including but not limited to publication, website and others.
4. All contact info could be open for public access for free.
